

Extra Credit Beach Cleanup Saturday September 19, 2015 9:00 am – 12:00 noon

For this optional extra credit opportunity, you'll be helping clean up trash on your choice of one of more than 100 different San Diego County coastal or inland locations. This year's statewide California Coastal Cleanup Day (CCD) is sponsored by many organizations including I Love A Clean San Diego. The cleanup is now part of the International Coastal Cleanup Day—the world's largest volunteer effort of its kind—and includes hundreds of thousands of volunteers in over 100 countries that pick up millions of pounds of debris each year. Not only is this a worthwhile endeavor because it helps clean our beaches, it's an education in and of itself about floating debris and how various items wind up as trash on the beach. For attending this beach cleanup, you will earn +5 extra credit points and +2 additional points for making a post about your experience on an online Discussion Board Forum.

To participate in this extra credit field trip, you <u>MUST REGISTER</u> for a particular site <u>BEFORE</u> the date of the cleanup at <u>http://cleanupday.org/</u>. You'll need to register so that they will have enough supplies for you (or bring your own gloves, bucket, and reusable water bottle). When you register, you'll be able to choose a location that's convenient for you. On the day of the cleanup, arrive on time and check in with the beach captain, who will be expecting you.

To receive your +5 points of extra credit, print this page and have the beach captain fill in the form below at the **end** of the cleanup. You can then send me the form via regular mail (see Contact Information at my Website <u>http://www2.palomar.edu/users/atrujillo/</u> for mailing address) or scan it and send it via e-mail. I will verify the information with I Love A Clean San Diego and will award you +5 extra credit points. Please make a post in the appropriate Discussion Board Forum at the class Blackboard site within the following week to receive +2 additional points. You may bring friends and family to the cleanup but I cannot offer you any additional extra credit for them. Thanks for helping clean up our local beaches!
