- Advisory board or study panel member (e.g., DSB, NRC, NASA)

FROM MY PROSPECTIVE

- P&T process is extrapolating impact over 30+ years from a few data points
- Consistent improvement is what we look for
 - Unjustified spurts are flags
- Balance between quality and quantityboth have their place
- Poor teaching will hurt you
 - Good teaching takes time and is worthwhile
- Beware of overdoing service but ZERO service is a flag
 - Learn to say no...often
 - Pick something you enjoy
