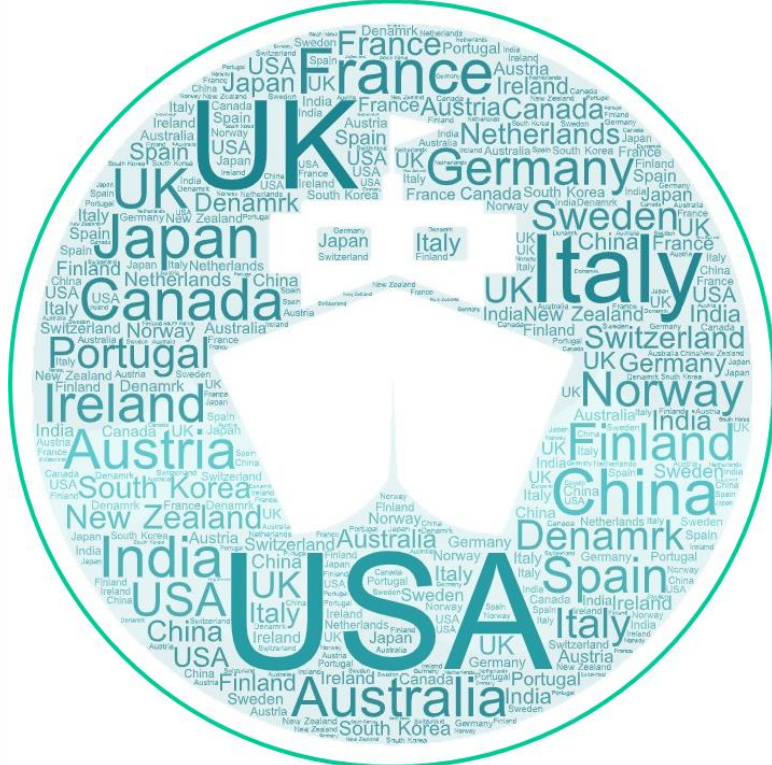

THE INTERNATIONAL OCEAN DISCOVERY PROGRAM (IODP) is the South Atlantic Ocean research drilling program (2013-2023) in addition to existing scientific understanding of Earth processes by sampling and observing subsurface environments using land-based and seafloor-based platforms. Today scientists are expanding deep-sea research by using multiple drilling platforms to explore IODP's principal research themes: deep-sea and planetary processes and geodynamics.

IODP drilling platforms are operated by the IODP Executive Agency Operator (EAO) at Texas A&M University Institute for Marine Earth and Environmental Engineering (IMEE), Japan, and the European Consortium for Ocean Research

Deep Sea Drilling Project Leg 1-46, Ocean Drilling Program Leg. 189-216, International Ocean Drilling Program Operations, 1995-2001, and International Ocean Discovery Program Operations 2001-2016.
