- Applications for this <u>professional development opportunity</u> are open to those currently teaching middle school or high school Earth Science or Environmental Science, or those who plan to.
- "The Model-Evidence Link project is hosting two in-person Earth and Environmental Science Educators' Institutes on Wednesday, July 20, 2022, from 9 AM to 4 PM, held in conjunction with the NSTA National Conference on Science Education in Chicago. One institute is for in-service teachers, and one is for pre-service teachers. The one-day institute is free, and a \$1000 stipend to help defray travel expenses will be provided after institute requirements have been completed. Required participation includes pre-institute homework and webinar, full participation in the institute, and full participation in institute evaluations. Applicants will be notified of a decision by May 13, 2022.
