<u>NSF-funded WISER Program</u> seeks candidates to teach Secondary STEM. TED members who know geoscience or other STEM undergraduates or recent graduates whom they think may be interested in this program should contact Christopher Roemmele at <u>croemmele@wcupa.edu</u> or 610-436-2108.

"With funding from the National Science Foundation NOYCE grant, West Chester University (WCU) is offering the West Chester University Improving STEM Education through Residency (WISER) Program in which candidates will earn a Master's Degree and teaching certification in 13 months. Candidates in the program will take coursework such as secondary STEM teaching and learning outcomes, supporting English Language Learners, and literacy development, as well as a full semester of student teaching. Candidates will also have the opportunity to teach in a high-needs school (rural or urban). The Noyce Team at WCU is currently recruiting people with undergraduate or graduate degrees in STEM-related fields to apply for our first cohort of NOYCE scholars. The application deadline is March 1, 2023."
