*Eldorado Canyon State Park is southwest of Boulder, CO. It has near- vertical exposures of the ~300-Ma Fountain Formation sandstone. The sandstone has well defined beds and joints making it a straightforward place for students to start with on kinematic analysis. This photograph set was taken from the east end of the Fowler Trail in a section called the Bastille. This set of photographs can be used for conducting a slope design for a hypothetical road widening.*
